 CHOKING HAZARD-Small parts. ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED. This package contains small parts which, before assembly, present a choking hazard to children under the age of three. FALL HAZARD: -To help prevent falls, do not use this bassinet for a child who can roll over or push up on hands and knees or who has reached 20 lb, whichever comes first. A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.


# SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infants have suffocated:

- In gaps between extra padding and side of the bassinet/cradle, and
- On soft bedding
- Use only the pad provided by manufacturer. NEVER add a pillow, comforter, or another mattress for padding.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- Always place baby on back to sleep to reduce the risk of SIDS and suffocation.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
- Never use without a mattress pad.
- Use only the sheet that is provided with the mattress pad for the bassinet. Call Kolcraft for a replacement cover / pad.
- Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use mode—bedside sleeper as well as the bassinet or both.


#### **△WARNING**

- This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 19 and 31 inches from floor to top of adult mattress, with a bottom clearance of at least 2 inches in height and depth, and with the mattress and frame in-line.
- The bedside sleeper CANNOT be used with adult beds without frames or adult beds where the mattress, boxspring, and frame are not in-line.

• The attachment system must always be used in bedside sleeper mode.



• To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.


**ENTRAPMENT HAZARD:** To prevent death from entrapment, bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.


- There must be no more than 1/2 in. gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed.
- Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.
- If gap exceeds 1/2 in., DO NOT use product. Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.









Adjust height of the Bassinet so that the top of the open Bassinet door is no higher than the top of the adult bed mattress. Make sure the height settings match on both sides. See 2-3 for height adjustment info.





Attach **BED STRAPS (GT)** to connections underneath the Bassinet. Make sure the buckles are secured before proceeding to the next step.






#### **CONVERTING BACK TO BASSINET MODE**







#### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- Mattress: Spot clean with mild solution of soap and water as needed.
- Fitted sheet: Remove from mattress. Machine wash in cold water. No bleach. Tumble dry on low heat and remove promptly. Do not iron.
- Main frame fabric cover and storage basket (if storage basket is included):
  Remove from frame. Remove top rail from cover. Machine wash in cold water. No
  bleach. Tumble dry on low heat and remove promptly. Do not iron. After drying
  reinstall top rail into cover ensuring elastic loops (2) are used.
